



KNOW

1) DIGITAL COMPETENCES

- To be able to use computers and all principal softwares;
- to attend at least one course on technology in teaching including about online safety;
- to be aware of/participate in research at local/national or international on digital competences and innovation.





KNOW

2) SUBJECT KNOWLEDGE

- To hold higher education or recognised qualification in your subject of teaching;
- to have completed training in subject specific pedagogy;
- to update subject knowledge (at least once every two years).






KNOW

3) FOREIGN LANGUAGE COMPETENCES

- To have certified or uncertified English/ foreign language competences at B1/B2 (intermediate) level knowledge;
- to participate in international exchange of staff/pupils at least every three years, in person or online;
- to be able to make a presentation in the target language.





KNOW

4) PEDAGOGICAL COMPETENCES

- To have been trained in pedagogy and keep oneself updated about new developments;
- to be able to choose the right methodology for each learning context;
- to use metareflexive and metacognitive tools in one's teaching.





KNOW

5) KNOWLEDGE OF LAWS AND ETHICS CONCERNING EDUCATION (NATIONAL AND EUROPEAN LEVEL)

- To have updated knowledge of national documents on education;
- to have updated knowledge of European guidelines on education;
- to participate in the implementation of new laws/policies/guidelines and professional code of ethics.





KNOW HOW

1) CLASS MANAGEMENT

•To be able to mediate;

•to be able to cultivate an inclusive environment;

•To have attended in-service training on class management.





KNOW HOW

2) DIDACTIC STRATEGIES AND CLASS PLANNING

To be trained on pedagogical theories and methodologies;

•to maintain knowledge of national and institution expected outcomes and curricula;

•to have individual or shared reflection on one's practice every term.





KNOW HOW

3) RELATIONSHIPS AT SCHOOL

To have attended psychological training;

 to take part in significant collaborative work with colleagues at least once a year;

•to dedicate some time every day to informal interactions with colleagues, parents or others at school.





KNOW HOW

4) ASSESSMENT OF LEARNING

To have been trained in assessment methodologies/practice;

•to be able to build fair and objective assessment tools for different types of evaluation;

to share assessment criteria with pupils and families.





KNOW HOW

5) RESEARCH AND STRATEGIC PLANNING

•To have been trained in research and planning (at initial or in-service training-PHD/master/course);

•to participate in research or project planning at different levels (school/higher education) at least every two years;

•To coordinate/create/collaborate in local/national/international projects to implement continuous improvement.
